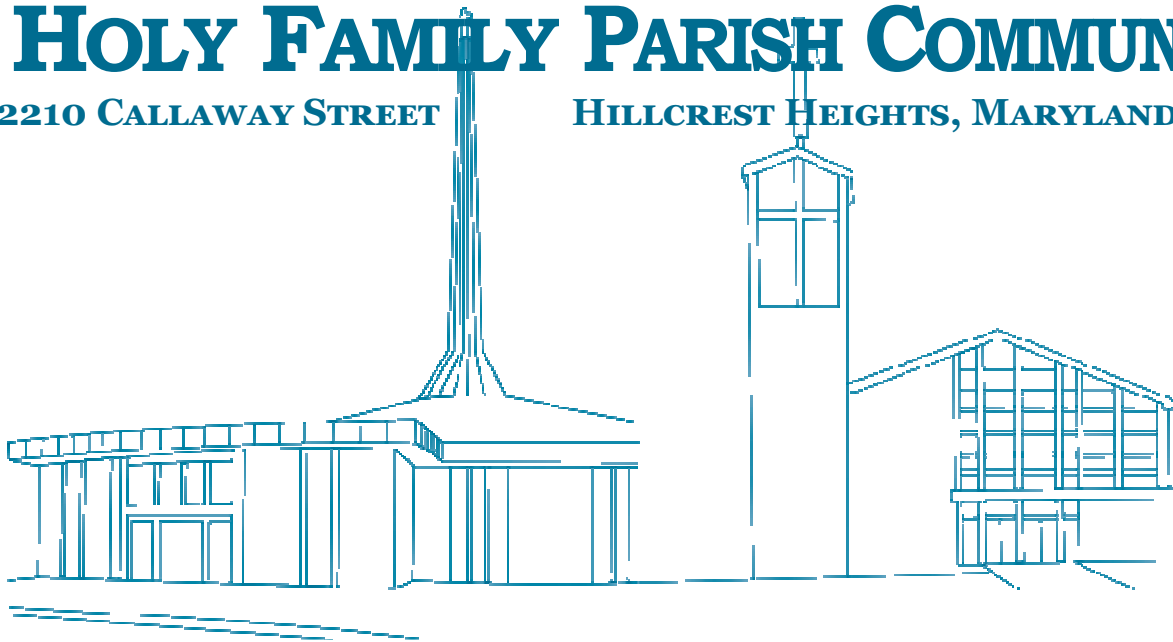

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

During our celebration of Pentecost last week, I announced a summer series that we can each participate in during our Sunday liturgy, at home viewing online videos and by creating small groups. The topic: The Wild Goose. We think of the Holy Spirit as a dove descending on Jesus at his Baptism and the wind and the fire descending on the Church at Pentecost. However, there is a tradition in the Church to think of the Holy Spirit as a Wild Goose. Why? When we see power and wildness of the Holy Spirit, the description of a Wild Goose may be a better fit. The Spirit comes in power. The Spirit comes bringing the breath of life. You never know what the Goose is going to do. The Holy Spirit has been given to us not as a possession to be tamed or controlled, but rather as a Person that will lead us to the Heart of God.

As our community comes out of Pentecost, with the online series called The Wild Goose, we will join Father Dave Pivonka T.O.R. on an unforgettable journey towards discovering a deeper relationship with the Holy Spirit. We will discover the Holy Spirit who has been revealed to us by Jesus Christ and who leads us to our heavenly Father. Each week, we will discuss an attribute of the Holy Spirit, a practical application on how to respond to the Holy Spirit and testimonies of people whose lives have been impacted by the Spirit of God.

The Wild Goose Series is a work of the Holy Spirit, which is awakening in the hearts of all those participating God's love and transforming power. As we walk through this series I will continually be praying that you will encounter the Holy Spirit and that the Spirit will breathe life into your very being.

Please sign up at www.thewildgooseisloose.com and begin watching week by week. Starting this week, we will reflect on the Holy Spirit as God's Love Poured out. In person, discussion groups or 'call-ins' will be set up as the series continues. This will guide us through our summer as schedules change and we have fewer activities at the parish.

Please take a few minutes each week to view the online video. Ask your children or friends to help you with this if you are unfamiliar with online videos. We are all asked to be a part of this to discover a deeper relationship with the Holy Spirit.
