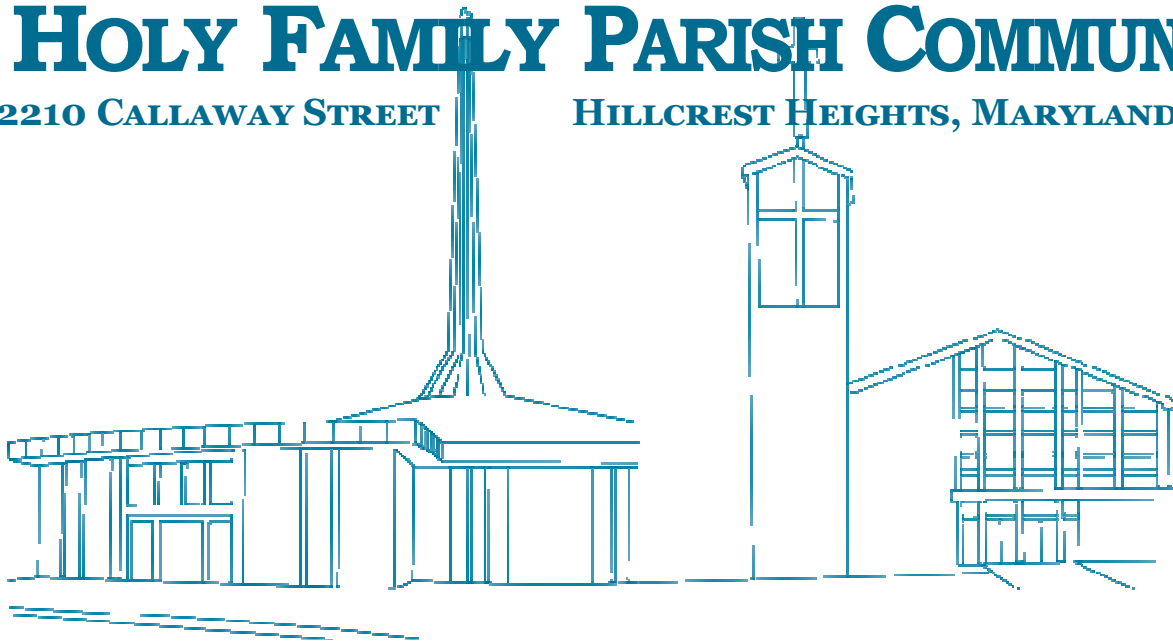

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This past weekend, I shared news about my transfer to Saint John Neumann Parish in Gaithersburg, Maryland. Many feel the shock, myself included. While my term as Pastor was intended to be six years, it was determined by the Cardinal and his advisors that I needed to return to Saint John to continue my priestly ministry. If you remember, I came to you from that parish in 2013. I was assigned as the Parochial Vicar and thought I had 2 or 3 years to walk with the people before being made Pastor at another parish. Back in 2013, the need to come to Holy Family arose and our relationship began.

As I looked out on the congregation, I saw faces of those who five years ago were strangers but now are people I know and love. The years have been incredible as I have been with you for half of my priestly ministry. Time really flew. Your faces represented the families that I have counseled as loved ones have died; people who have come for counseling or confession; family homes that I have blessed. As we are open to the Holy Spirit, so we will continue to do the good work that the Good Lord shares with us. As our lives are healed and transformed, so will the lives of others around us. I'm living proof of the transforming power of love in the midst of confusion and doubt about serving as a Pastor. You have helped form my heart and mind for serving in other places. I can never and will never forget you.

I have great hopes for you and for Father Matt who comes to walk with you the next few years. You are in the hands of the Lord and continue to walk with great faith in his abundant love and mercy.

We celebrate Corpus Christi and are reminded that though physically separated we meet each other into eternity when we come to worship Christ in the Eucharist. For this is the way that is meant when he said, "I will be with you always!"

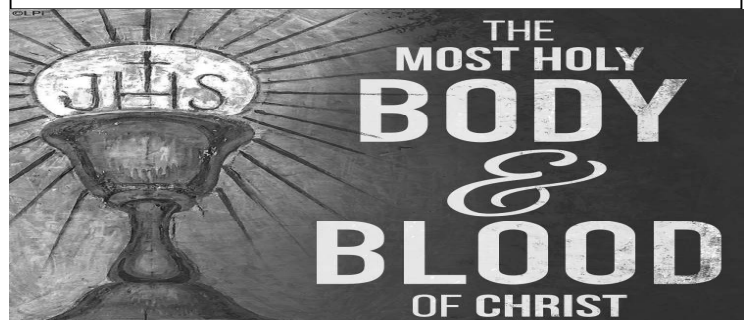
